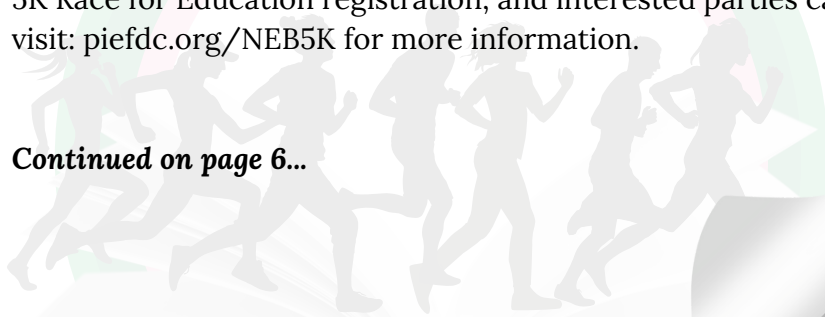

Kenyatta Robinson is a graduate of Friendship Tech Preparatory Academy and will be attending Louisiana State University and will major in Accounting.



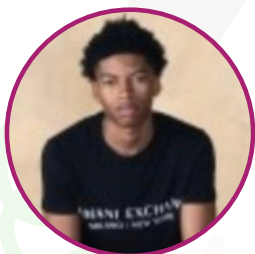
Laila Pettus is a graduate of Benjamin Banneker Academic High School and will be attending the University of Miami, and will major in Journalism with a minor in Spanish.

Omolade Ejiko is a graduate of Phelps A.C.E. High School and will be attending the University of the District of Columbia. Omolade will major in Computer Science.





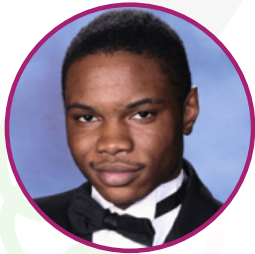

How much do tickets cost?

1. Visit piefdc.org/legacyfund or talk with a PIEF ambassador on establishing an unrestricted \$5,000 or restricted \$10,000.
2. PIEF forms will need to be completed, notarized, and submitted with a deposit, either \$500 or \$1,000, depending on whether the fund is unrestricted or restricted.
3. PIEF will process the paperwork internally and ensure all the scholarship criteria is properly established.
4. PIEF donations are tax deductible and will be recognized.

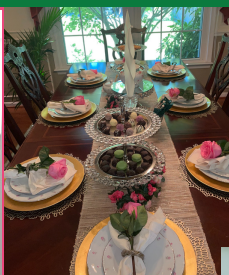
